75th Avenue Off-Ramp from Inbound Peña Boulevard to Close Overnight on August 9 & 10

DENVER – Aug. 8, 2022 – On Tuesday, Aug. 9, and Wednesday, Aug. 10 starting at 8 p.m. until 4 a.m. the next morning, Denver International Airport (DEN) will close the 75th Avenue off-ramp from inbound Peña Boulevard for annual road repairs, weather permitting. This is the off-ramp to rental car returns and Final Approach (the cell phone waiting lot). The right lane before the off-ramp will also be closed.

During the closure, a detour will be in place requiring motorists to take the next exit at Jackson Gap Street.

- After exiting on Jackson Gap, turn left at the stoplight.
- Follow Jackson Gap until it stops at 78th Ave.
- Turn left on 78th Ave to return rental cars and proceed to Gun Club Road to go to Final Approach

This annual pavement rehabilitation project [a part of Vision 100](#) started after the July 4th holiday and will continue through September, weather permitting.
