The *Colfax Avenue: The Longest Continuous Street in the USA* exhibit will be on display through June 2019. It is located on Ansbacher Hall in the Jeppesen Terminal, Level 6 North, before A Bridge Security. Historical and modern artifacts in the exhibit tell just a portion of the Colfax Avenue story. If only the featured neon signs, murals, old road signs and photographs could talk.


