Denver International Airport to Host COVID-19 Vaccine Booster Clinics for Employees and Passengers


DENVER – Jan. 13, 2022 – Denver International Airport (DEN) will once again offer COVID-19 vaccine booster shots for passengers and airport employees on various days throughout the remainder of January and all of February.

Anyone 12 years and older is eligible for a booster shot. Booster shots will be available by appointment only, no walk-ins allowed. Both Pfizer and Moderna vaccines will be offered and first and second dose shots can also be scheduled. The CDC has provided [guidance](#) regarding the COVID-19 booster shot, which you should review prior to scheduling an appointment.

Passengers and airport employees may [schedule](#) an appointment to get their booster shot during the following dates and times.

- **January 18:** 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- **January 22:** 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- **January 26:** 2 p.m. to 8 p.m.
- **January 28:** 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- **January 31:** 2 p.m. to 8 p.m.
- **February 2:** 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- **February 7:** 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- **February 10:** 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- **February 13:** 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- **February 15:** 2 p.m. to 8 p.m.
- **February 28:** 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Appointments are located at Denver International Airport on the 4th floor of the Hotel and Transit Center on the far northwest side of the DEN Plaza. Signs are located on the Plaza labeled “Health Appointment,” which will direct in front of Tom’s Urban Restaurant, then direct north toward the terminal to the entrance of the vaccination clinic.



Take the RTD A-Line for a short walk to the clinic, or park in one of [DEN's parking facilities](#). DEN garage parking costs \$5 per hour and is also a short walk to the clinic.

What You Need for Your Appointment

- Please complete the Safeway/Albertson's release form prior to your appointment (you can download and print the form after you schedule your appointment).
- Individuals with insurance, please **bring your medical and prescription insurance cards** to the appointment. Safeway will ask for Name, Date of Birth, and insurance information. Your insurance information will be used to bill for the federally approved amount, and you should not receive any bill. Medicare recipients need to bring their new Medicare Part B card (red, white and blue).
- Individuals with no insurance can receive vaccine through this program. Government funds will cover the cost of vaccine dispensing for those who are uninsured.
- **Please do not show up to your appointment more than 15 minutes early – you will be asked to come back at your appointment time.**
- Use your confirmation link to reschedule or cancel an appointment, if needed.

Vaccine Booster Fast Facts

- Safeway/Albertsons will be administering Pfizer and Moderna COVID-19 vaccines.
- You may select whether to receive a Moderna or a Pfizer booster shot regardless of which vaccine you received previously (Moderna, Pfizer or Johnson & Johnson).
- Those who are 12-17 years old will receive the Pfizer vaccine only.
- People with a history of severe allergic reactions (e.g., carry an epi-pen) should consult with their primary care physician prior to receiving the vaccine booster.
- You will be required to wait approximately 15 minutes after receiving vaccine booster before being released.
