DEN is committed to regionalism and deeply values their partnerships among neighbors and stakeholders. The Study will provide meaningful opportunities for public and stakeholder participation at key milestones throughout the study to ensure their feedback is considered and incorporated into the proposed solutions. With all the ongoing growth and development in the region, the public and stakeholders have already been engaged on several planning studies within or adjacent to the Study area, in particular Denver's Department of Transportation and Infrastructure's [Far Northeast Area Plan](#). The Study team wants to be thoughtful in their engagement efforts to ensure previous stakeholder and public comments and visions are considered before re-engagement occurs.

DEN currently engages with many of its neighboring agencies on a monthly or quarterly cadence to keep them informed of ongoing programs and projects at DEN. Due to the regional context of Peña Boulevard, the Study is expanding stakeholder engagement to include:

- Denver City Council
- Federal Aviation Administration (FAA)
- Surrounding Local and Transportation Agencies
- Local and Regional Advocacy Groups
- Local Businesses
- General Public

The surrounding transportation agencies, local agencies, and advocacy groups will be invited to join the Study's Stakeholder Working Group (SWG). The SWG and public will have the opportunity to review and comment on project study elements including project goals; existing conditions; proposed alternatives; equity considerations, and other recommendations. The Study team aims to host the first public and SWG meetings in early 2023. More details will be provided later this year.
