Public Engagement Preparation (more details to come in early 2023)

The Study team is planning to formally engage with the public on three occasions throughout the Study. The first of these touchpoints is tentatively scheduled for late Feb. 2023 where DEN will host two in-person public open houses in Montbello and Green Valley Ranch.

The first public open house intends to:


- Initiate communication with the public
- Present the Study's purpose, need, goals and objectives
- Present work accomplished to date (surveys, etc.)
- Present a summary of an existing conditions assessment
- Understand the transportation/mobility challenges and opportunities within the Study area
- Solicit community input on potential alternatives
- Present the next steps for the Study

In addition to the two in-person public open houses, the Study team will also host virtual engagements to ensure that:

- Passengers, stakeholders and the public have an opportunity to share their voices and learn about the Peña Boulevard Transportation and Mobility Master Plan
- Community members from Montbello and Green Valley Ranch who cannot attend the in-person meetings have an opportunity to engage with the Study

Additional public engagement is planned in early summer and early fall 2023 to present proposed and preferred solutions and recommendations from the Study. Materials for the first engagement events are currently being developed and more details will follow in early 2023.

Vehicle Occupancy Counts

In early November, vehicle occupancy counts were conducted to understand the number of people in vehicles traveling on Peña Boulevard. The goal of the Study is to reduce the amount of single-occupancy vehicles on Peña Boulevard. Understanding existing occupancy rates will help DEN to develop strategies to encourage the use of ride-share, carpools and public transportation along the corridor. The count data is currently being processed and results will be available in early 2023.



Mobility Surveys

As part of the Mobility Study, DEN is conducting surveys of passengers, tenants and employees to understand their transportation needs and challenges when traveling to the airport. For more background on these surveys, see the [November monthly update](#).

The passenger surveys closed in Aug. 2022 with over 5,000 responses collected. As of early December, almost 2,500 employee responses have been collected and over 80 interview surveys have been conducted with the DEN tenants. All of the survey data is currently being processed and results will be available in early 2023.
